Unique properties and applications that make yellow cedar special !



- It is easy to work with, hence widely used for applications like joinery, decorative panelling, furniture, carving and moulding etc.
- It has extractives, making it naturally termite and decay-resistant. These properties, combined with its durability make it ideal for outdoor applications including pergolas, gazebos, garden furniture, cladding, decking, shingles and stairs. It is also used for making door/windows and door/window frames where durability is required.
- It has excellent strength-to-weight-ratio and compares favourably with popular hardwood species in terms of strength, durability, and stability.
- It scores over popular hardwood species in terms of stiffness, planing, mortising and nailing.
- It turns, planes and shapes very well and can be sanded to a smooth surface finish.
- Easy to edge glue, paint, stain or coat with a clear finish.

Suitability for door, door frames and windows

Wood species used for doors/windows, and door/window frames need to meet very demanding conditions as opposed to wood used for interiors. The wood species thus used must be durable and have excellent dimensional stability. Hence yellow cedar ticks the right boxes for such applications.
